



Lint Busters? Expands Custom Branding Options for Commercial Lint Rollers

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Lint Busters?, a division of Pepin Manufacturing, is expanding awareness of its custom branding options for commercial lint rollers as organizations prepare for fall events, corporate giveaways, and multi-location facility programs. The company manufactures American-made lint removal products at its Minnesota facility and has supported commercial buyers for more than 25 years. The custom program allows businesses to apply logos, colors, and messaging to handles or packaging for use in hospitality kits, staff supplies, trade show materials, and branded facility inventories.

Custom-printed lint rollers have become a practical option for companies that want a functional item to carry a brand mark rather than a disposable promotional trinket. Lint Busters? reports that standard custom orders can begin at relatively low quantities compared with many private-label programs, while larger private-label runs are available for organizations that need higher volume. Production lead times are typically three to four weeks, with rush options available when event dates require a tighter schedule. Design support is included as part of the ordering process.

The program is intended for commercial buyers across hospitality, healthcare, veterinary, manufacturing,

clothing processing, and janitorial operations. Hotels and resorts use branded rollers in housekeeping carts and guest-facing kits. Corporate offices and event teams use them as giveaways that remain in circulation after a conference or trade show. Facilities that manage uniforms or public-facing textiles use custom handles to keep supplies consistent across locations.

Steve Yulga, Sales and Marketing Manager for Lint Busters?, stated, "Custom branding gives purchasing teams a way to standardize a daily maintenance tool while keeping the product tied to their own identity. The program is built around commercial order sizes rather than one-off retail packaging."

Lint Busters? produces its rollers entirely in the United States. The commercial lineup includes the Pro 8 Industrial Lint Roller for high-volume maintenance work, standard commercial rollers for facilities cleaning, and Hair Busters rollers formulated for pet hair in veterinary clinics, grooming operations, and pet-friendly hospitality settings. Custom branding can be applied across selected configurations so that a property or company can match handle appearance to existing brand guidelines.

Customer reviews published on the company website describe adhesive performance and handle durability in professional use. One purchaser noted that rolls contain 60 sheets, remain on the handle during use, and peel cleanly when a sheet is finished. Another described the metal handle as more durable than plastic handles used in earlier purchases. A third review focused on pet hair removal after the buyer had tried multiple other brands. These comments appear on the company?s site as third-party purchase feedback rather than as commissioned testimonials.

Lincoln Caldon, Sales Manager for Lint Busters?, added, "Buyers usually come to the custom program with a specific use in mind, whether that is a hospitality welcome kit or a multi-site maintenance cart. The conversation starts with quantity, artwork, and the roller format that fits the job."

The company also supplies bulk cases and refill programs for organizations that already have handles in circulation. That structure allows a branded handle to stay in service while adhesive rolls are replenished. The approach is consistent with the firm?s broader commercial model, which emphasizes repeatable supply for maintenance teams rather than single-unit retail sales.

Fall calendars often include trade shows, corporate meetings, and seasonal staffing changes in hospitality and retail. Those cycles increase demand for items that can be ordered in defined quantities and delivered on a known timeline. Lint Busters? positions the custom program as part of that planning cycle rather than as a separate consumer promotion.

Pepin Manufacturing, the parent company of Lint Busters?, is a family-owned contract manufacturer based in Minnesota. The organization produces lint and tick removal products under the Lint Busters? brand and

supplies commercial dry cleaners, facilities operators, and other professional users nationwide. Domestic production supports quality control and order consistency for buyers who manage inventory across more than one location.

Lint Busters? continues to serve manufacturing, food processing, healthcare, hospitality, janitorial services, clothing processing, veterinary, and automotive operations. Custom branding is one of several commercial services offered alongside bulk packaging and product recommendations based on the cleaning environment. The company remains focused on American-made production and long-term supply relationships with professional buyers.
