Existing ducts may require modifications to accommodate a replacement system or address airflow needs throughout the property. Homes constructed before central cooling became common can present additional challenges, including limited space for ducts, older electrical infrastructure, and layouts that were not originally designed around contemporary HVAC equipment.
