



Sell Your Houses Quickly Addresses Stalled Vacant Property Sales

Sell Your Houses Quickly, a cash home buying company based in Greensboro, North Carolina, is setting out the circumstances behind one of the most common seller situations it encounters: a house left standing empty long enough that clearing and repairing it would cost more than the owner is willing or able to spend before a sale. The company has purchased houses in that condition throughout the Triad region of North Carolina since 2022.

Sell Your Houses Quickly provides As-Is Property Purchase for homeowners and heirs across Greensboro, buying property in its existing condition with no repairs required, no cleaning expected, and no obligation on the owner to empty the house first. Belongings may be left where they are, an allowance that carries weight where a house holds decades of accumulated contents. Each completed purchase in the city is recorded with the Guilford County Register of Deeds, the office through which title to property in the county changes hands.

A vacant property rarely becomes a problem in a single step. Typically, a house passes to a family member,

or an owner moves out and does not return, and the decision about what to do with it is deferred while taxes, insurance, and slow deterioration continue to run against it. By the time selling is looked at seriously, the repair estimate has grown, an estate clearance that nobody in the family has time to carry out sits in the way, and the house is harder to bring to market than it was two years earlier.

Resolving that situation without a listing follows a different route. A walkthrough of the property in its current state comes first, followed by a written offer, with the closing date chosen by the seller. The offer begins from the After Repair Value of the house, the figure it would sell for on the open market once fully repaired, and a description of how the process works is published online. Warranty deed, closing fee, and title insurance are paid by the buyer.

“A house that has been sitting for years is one of the situations we see most often, and by the time the owner calls, they have usually decided that nobody will look at it until it has been emptied and repaired,” said Rudolph Francis, Owner at Sell Your Houses Quickly. “That is not how we buy. The furniture can stay, the roof can stay as it is, and we do not ask the owner to spend a dollar getting the place ready.”

One Greensboro purchase followed that pattern closely. The house had stood empty for a long stretch, and the work needed to bring it to a condition a retail buyer would accept was well beyond what the owner intended to fund. It was bought as it stood, with no repair work and no clear-out asked of the owner first. Properties in that state turn up across established residential areas of the city, including neighborhoods such as Fisher Park.

Sell Your Houses Quickly is a BBB Accredited Business with an A+ rating, accredited since 2024. The company's stated position is that a cash sale is not the right outcome for every property, and that an owner whose house and timeline would both support a conventional listing should be told as much rather than sold to.

“There are sellers I have told to list with an agent instead, because that was plainly the better result for them,” Rudolph Francis said. “I am not interested in buying a property that a seller would look back on and regret selling to me. Every offer that goes out has my name on it, and I review each one myself before it reaches the seller. I came into this work from medicine after mitigating a foreclosure for a family member, and the values I brought with me are the same values medicine taught me: competency, consistency, fairness, and transparency.”

Vacant and un-cleared houses are a standing feature of the residential market in Greensboro and across the Triad, and what an owner in that position is able to do about it determines whether the house is sold or
