But with over under photos the camera has to consider both - the brighter upper half and the darker lower half. Even with big dynamic range of the new GoPro cameras this can be a problem."

The split dome port is designed to separate the water from the camera's lens, creating a buffer which dramatically increases the clarity of the photos taken. The latest blog post features a number of ways which photographers can benefit from the use of the dome port. It offers suggestions such as getting as close as possible, so as to remove excess water between

camera and subject, as well as waiting for sunny skies and clear waters before attempting photos. This reduces murkiness, and darkness which could result in a loss of clarity, because while the dome is said to improve clarity, Splitgadget admits that it does require some manual assistance.
