If those with gum disease would request for regular teeth cleaning, the dentist would likely refuse to do so because it would be unethical knowing that periodontitis should be treated or it would lead to tooth loss and other health problems."

Regular cleaning focuses only on the teeth above the gum line. A deep dental cleaning, which uses scaling and root planing, focuses under the gum line where bacteria, debris and tartar have accumulated. The tartar

under the gum line is where bacteria can thrive because they cannot be eliminated by regular teeth cleaning, brushing or flossing. This causes inflammation resulting into bone loss and loose teeth.
