Before she even gets into the actual writing process, Kuhn helps her students explore their niche and their book topic to ensure they will find an eager audience for their book. Knowing that there are readers just waiting for the information they plan to share can be very motivating for writers, inspiring them to get their book finished.

Kuhn's course also includes several stress management techniques as well as tips on how to overcome procrastination, in order to make the writing process into a much more enjoyable experience. "Writing any book can be very intimidating," Kuhn says, "which often leads to writer's block and procrastination. That's why I have included a number of tools that help with overcoming stress and writer's block."

In addition, she is currently working on a sequel to her course that will show her students how to be successful at selling their books and turning them into a truly profitable asset.

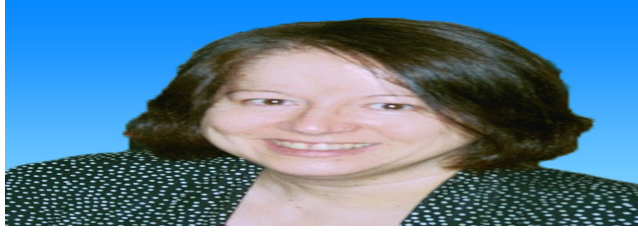
