This year sold \$950 in donated raffle prizes, \$36,650 contributed by hole-sponsors, and \$17,659 raised from the participants in entrance fees, raffle tickets, tips, and hole contests. One-hundred percent of the proceeds went to WRC, a hospital for sick, injured and orphaned wildlife.
