We felt like offering free haircuts and hygiene products would make it easier for the students to be ready for school, and to feel better about themselves as they start the new year.?

Hair stylists set up shop at the John Miller Community Center, at the same location the supplies were being offered, so families could avoid the transportation issues encountered when they have to go to multiple

locations.

"We put out the call for volunteers and donations at the beginning of summer, and we were just thrilled with the response," Fox said. "I feel very blessed to be able to contribute to my community this way, and really appreciate everyone who took part in the event."

In addition to the haircuts, 765 backpacks containing school supplies were given out, along with 365 hygiene packs. To make the afternoon and evening even more special, food and games were enjoyed by the students and their families.
