The programs offered by the organization help students and parents better prepare for a successful college career by outlining the differences in planning and funding and offering insights into financial preparation for school through grants, student loans, scholarships, and other means of taking care of education costs.

The HIFE College Planning Program helps students and parents to fully prepare and plan for college with

student assessments. These assessments include career exploration, which enables the student to

determine if their chosen degree is a good fit for them. The program recommends that students interview

someone in the career that they are considering to find out the pros and cons of those positions.

"Career guidance is an integral part of the process," says Anderson. "Students may grow up saying they want

to be a doctor but in actuality, perhaps this is the farthest thing from what they truly want to do."

Anderson states that exploring career choices and obtaining guidance in choosing the right career fit can help

to eliminate a number of college drop-out rates. Taking time when selecting a college is another way that

students can ensure they are going to "tough it out" during their college years.
