



## **Woman Files Talcum Powder Lawsuit On Behalf Of Grandmother**

Despite the split in the evidence, three juries have found that a link does exist and have awarded plaintiffs with millions in compensation. Meanwhile, two similar cases were thrown out in New Jersey by a judge who stated that there was a lack of scientific evidence to support the plaintiffs' claims.
