The highest number on the tile is the leading player. Throughout the balance of the game, the purpose is to match the number on one or more played tiles, until all tiles are in play. As tiles are played, additional tiles are drawn from the bone garden.?

When all tiles are in play, the player who clears the seven personal tiles first is the winner, while other players are ranked according to the number of remaining ?spots?. The goal is to have the fewest points in each round. This is a game that requires some luck and plenty of strategy, in order to have the lowest number of points. Children as well as adults can learn the rules and play the game.
