According to Kevin Donalson, "A balanced bat has the weight of the tool evenly distributed from the barrel to the knob at the end of the bat. A player can swing the bat with balance. Players use a balanced bat largely because it is predictable and controllable. Players are able to control the swing momentum of this type of bat, as well as the placement of the incoming ball upon the barrel."

He continues, "An end loaded bat is a bat in which the weight is not evenly distributed and some extra load, typically half an ounce or one ounce, are added towards the barrel-end so that the bat is barrel-heavy."

The advantage of using an end-loaded bat is that for a power player who can perfectly and confidently control the swing of the bat, swinging an end-loaded bat offers greater momentum and power through the hitting zone. An end-loaded bat, if wielded well by a player, typically hits longer shots than a balanced bat."
