The mudjacking process is simple and effective. When the concrete surface is uneven, a number of holes are first drilled into the sunken concrete. The holes which are drilled are less than two inches in diameter. Then a specially mixed grout is pumped below the concrete, raising it to the desired height. The grout is a mixture of clay, sand, cement and water, pumped under the concrete under hydraulic pressure. The holes are then patched with cement and within 24-48 hours the surface is once again ready for use.

A company representative explained to an interviewer, "Consultations and quotes for our services are free of charge, and in some cases we can even offer same-day service. He continues, "Void filling uses the same process as lifting concrete. A grout mixture is pumped under the cement into voids left under a fixed slab through soil erosion and settled or washed out base work. Void filling helps prevent sinking and cracking of hollowed cement. The surface is returned to full use within 48 hours or less."
