Although the bird homes look to be completely intact, the front of the house can be removed from top to bottom for easy cleaning, and Heirloom Culinary has made it clear that there is plenty of ventilation for easy breathing by those birds which choose to stay inside. More photographs of the house can be seen through the company's retail outlet, which shows the bird homes opening for cleaning, as well as closed and ready for birds to rest inside.
