



Hearing Center Opens In Scottsdale

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People in Scottsdale, AZ, have gladly welcomed Happy Ears Hearing Center to the community. The hearing center strives to help the people of Scottsdale have 'happy ears', offering the widest range of audiology services in the Scottsdale area. In fact, they even offer tinnitus treatment and can help with almost every hearing problem. Already known as a supplier of the best hearing aids Scottsdale residents can depend on, the company has been welcomed with open arms by everybody in the community.

A representative for Happy Ears Hearing Center says: "We are so happy to have been welcomed into the community. We proudly offer Arizona's widest range of audiology services, being experts in the latest hearing aid devices while also offering bone anchored hearing aids, cochlear implants, and treatment for tinnitus."

The business, as the name implies, wishes to help everybody experience 'happy hearing'. To achieve this, their team of audiologists always ensure that their knowledge is fully up to date with the latest developments in hearing healthcare. Treatment for hearing loss is one of the main services that the business offers. This starts with a diagnostic hearing evaluation. At this point, the audiologist determines whether there are any abnormalities present that may need medical treatment. Tests will be conducted to determine the presence of

hearing loss, its degree and type, the possible cause, and what treatment options would be most suitable.

The representative continues: "After your initial assessment, we will perform audiometric testing. This will help determine whether you can understand verbiage on short distances and in noisy situations. This tells us whether you may benefit from a hearing aid or whether you will need to see a medical specialist."

Happy Ears Hearing Center also offers tympanometry, whereby the middle ear and eardrum are examined for condition and mobility and how the conduction bones are functioning. This enables the audiologist to determine whether there is a middle ear problem that is leading to hearing loss, which is often correctable.

Those who do require hearing aids can also count on Happy Ears Hearing Center to have the most technologically advanced equipment available. According to the representative: "We offer the most technologically advanced digital hearing aids and offer a variety of options designed to meet any budget. We work with the top manufacturers to guarantee you quality hearing technology and customer service. If you need your hearing aids to work with Bluetooth technology, we can help you choose the hearing aid that is best for you."

All hearing aids are fitted through real ear verification. This ensures that the wearers will be able to maximize the benefits they will get from them. This is done both through programming software and through manual interventions. The result is that people who wear the hearing aids will immediately understand just how much they can benefit from them.

Furthermore, the company can help with earwax (cerumen) management. This wax protects the skin of the ear canal and stops water, bacteria, and debris from getting in. However, when there is an overproduction of wax, it can cause hearing impairment. A Happy Ears Hearing Center audiologist can help to remove this wax.

Of particular interest is that the clinic also offers cochlear implants. They are one of the few in the Phoenix area to offer both evaluations and mappings. Similarly, they offer treatment for bone anchored hearing devices, as well as demonstrations, fittings, and adjustments. A variety of hearing aid accessories are also available to further enhance people's hearing and enjoyment of sound. Uniquely, Happy Ears Hearing Center can even have an audiologist go to the patient's location, although this will depend on circumstances.

Finally, the clinic offers treatment for tinnitus. The representative explains: "It is important to know what tinnitus is. Around 10% to 15% of the population is affected by this condition, which is basically a ringing in the ears. People who suffer from tinnitus have a pulsing and/or tonal constant sound in their ears while others cannot hear this sound. Sometimes, the noise is so loud that it becomes impossible for people to hear actual sound around them. Our audiologists understand tinnitus and the negative impact it has on quality of life. We can help, and encourage you to attend our clinic as soon as possible."

Those presenting with tinnitus will also be fully evaluated in order to determine the cause of their condition. In so doing, the audiologist will also be better able to find an appropriate solution. Being able to find relief from this condition is something that has filled many with hope and enhanced so many lives.
