He explains that the mommy makeover is not just for moms but it is a combination of several plastic surgery procedures that can help moms regain the bodies they previously had before childbirth. As such, the mommy makeover services are designed to take care of various issues, such as loose skin, stretch marks, misshapen belly buttons, sagging breasts, excess fat, deflated breasts, or any other characteristics often found on a post-baby body.

The traditional mommy makeover includes a tummy tuck and breast augmentation. The mommy makeover Maryland plastic surgeon points out that breast lifts are usually done in addition to the breast augmentation. He explains that because of the increased weight of the breasts during pregnancy and breastfeeding, moms often have sagging and droopy breasts. Aside from being visually unattractive, such breasts may feel uncomfortable or painful. If the breasts have become significantly larger, some women decide to have a breast reduction procedure.

Meanwhile, it is understandable that tummy tucks are often included in mommy makeovers because the abdominal skin and muscles are stretched considerably during pregnancy in order to accommodate the fetus. In addition, pregnant women often experience weight gain before and after childbirth. The result is excess fat or skin around their stomach. Dr. Schreiber often recommends liposuction in addition to the tummy tuck for

best results. He may also suggest some non-surgical treatments for removing cellulite.

One advantage of having liposuction, according to Dr. Schreiber, is that they can use the fat that has been removed and have it injected into their buttocks. This is known as the Brazilian butt lift, which improves the volume and shape of the buttocks. This provides the desired hourglass shape that makes a woman appear slimmer. For those who didn't have a liposuction procedure, silicone butt implants can be used instead.
