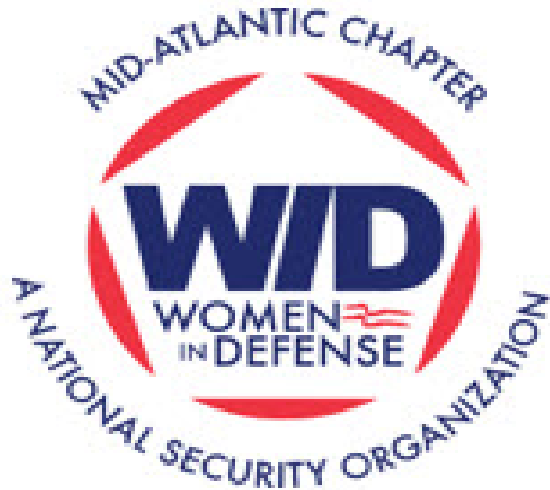




The National Veterans Opportunity Coalition (TNVOC) Supports Women In Defense Conference
