Digital thermometers record body temperature with heat sensors, while mercury thermometers use mercury, which can be toxic if the glass is broken and the mercury escapes. Digital thermometers are recommended more and more by physicians today for taking the temperature in the mouth, under the arm and rectally.

Doctors point out that under the arm thermometers typically give the least accurate temperature readings. Rectal temperature taking is best for infants, particularly those under three months of age, because it is much more accurate than temperatures taken anywhere else on the body. With regards to oral temperature taking, it can be difficult to get young children to keep their mouth closed while the temperature is being taken. Rectal thermometers offer a much more accurate reading and an easier way to take temperature and iProven states that their new rectal thermometer makes it even easier still to get that accurate reading.

Doctors do recommend labeling rectal thermometers so that they are never used to take the temperature orally. The company states that their new thermometer can be washed and sanitized so there are no worries of mixing it up with other thermometers. Parents can simply clean it when the temperature is taken so that it is safe to use again for taking the temperature in any fashion.

Mercury thermometers were once the only type that one would find in a medicine cabinet. Today, however, digital thermometers have taken their place. Mercury thermometers are not recommended by physicians today because of the toxicity of the mercury, particularly for use on infants and younger children. Digital thermometers offer a more accurate reading, are easier to use and provide temperature readings much more quickly than mercury thermometers.
