

## Doctors Immediate Care Urgent Care Walk-In Clinic Opens In Lombard

Lombard, IL - Doctors Immediate Care has announced that they have recently opened a walk-in clinic in Lombard, IL. They are an independent medical provider of urgent care services in several neighborhoods in the Chicago area in the state of Illinois. They are open most days of the week and year to provide treatment of non life threatening injuries and illnesses.

James Roosevelt from Doctors Immediate Care says, "Our doctors office and urgent care visits typically cost a fraction of a trip to the emergency room and our immediate care patients are generally seen within the hour. With the increasing demand, we found that there was a need to establish a walk-in clinic in Lombard. Thus, we are happy to announce that residents within the Lombard area can now visit our walk-in clinic whenever they feel they have a medical emergency due to an injury or illness that is non life threatening."

James explained that their walk-in clinics are open for those who find that their primary doctor's office is closed but need urgent care services for minor emergencies, such as fever, coughs, cuts, lacerations, and the like. Doctors Immediate Care offers full service walk-in medical clinics. Aside from the new location in Lombard, they have several other clinics serving areas within Chicago, Villa Park, Downers Grove, Oak

Brook, Elmhurt, Northlake, Ohare International Airport, Wheaton, Glen Ellyn, and Naperville.

The team of doctors and staff at the Doctors Immediate Care walk-in clinics are board certified. Patients can just walk in and there are often no wait times. Furthermore, the spokesperson points out that all tests and treatments have been designed to be affordable and the nurses and administrators are well aware of people's busy schedules.

James says, "We serve families and individuals of all ages and have pediatricians on call to assist in emergency needs also for those who cannot reach their primary care doctor, are visiting from out of town or are new to the area and currently do not have a doctor." He adds, "We offer full STD testing, HIV testing, drug testing, alcohol testing & testing, and pre employment physical exams and other employment services. Employees don't need an appointment."

The spokesperson states that Doctors Immediate Care accepts all insurances and people can just walk in to get treatment for a wide range of health conditions and problems. These include mild abdominal pain; colds, coughs and flu; mild to moderate allergic reactions; minor burns; fever; mild to moderate asthma attacks; minor fractures; minor eye injuries; sore throat; skin infections and rashes; scrapes, bruises and minor cuts; vomiting and diarrhea; urinary tract infections; sports injuries, sprains and strains, and falls; employment physicals; DOT physicals; and many more.

The spokesperson points out that doctors at Doctors Immediate Care are experienced in providing physicals to children. School physicals are often required by schools in the state of Illinois. The walk-in clinics offer parents a way for them to squeeze into their busy schedules the required physician exams for their children. The spokesperson says, "You can get the physical completed in a fraction of the time for a fraction of the price."

The Doctors Immediate Care walk-in clinics can also be used by people who need a physical exam and drug screen that is required for drivers with commercial loads as specified by the Department of Transportation (DOT). Doctors at the clinics are familiar with the DOT physical requirements and will perform the various items in the checklist.

The physicians at Doctors Immediate Care walk-in clinics are also prepared to provide executive physicals. The spokesperson points out that their mission is to offer quality preventive health care for executives through annuals evaluations and testing for most medical conditions. The physical exam includes glaucoma testing, history taking, complete blood analysis, thyroid testing, urine analysis, vision and audiometric testing, stool exam, EKG, PFT, and blood chemistry.

The Doctors Immediate Care walk in clinic can also provide testing for various kinds of sexually transmitted

diseases (STDs). These include the gonorrhea test, HIV-1 antibodies test, syphilis test, herpes simplex virus (HSV) type I test, HSV type II test, hepatitis B surface antigen test, hepatitis B core antibodies total test, hepatitis C antibody test, STD panel labs with urine and blood work, and chlamydia test.

Doctors Immediate Care walk-in clinics are also available for providing low-cost vaccines for infants, children, students and adults. This is essential because the State of Illinois mandates that all students should be able to provide proof that they have been vaccinated for Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR) and Tetanus/Diphtheria. Various colleges and universities have additional requirements for immunization and testing.
