Mims says that the new blog post was written to further educate people on the dangers of radon. Radon has been around for centuries. It comes from the decay of uranium and is a naturally occurring gas. Environmentally speaking, radon is found in higher levels in some areas than others, so certain geographical locations will contain higher risks of exposure to this gas. Those who are exposed to radon face a number of health risks. This known carcinogen has been estimated to be the second leading cause of lung cancer in patients in the United States. It rates second only to smoking and according to the EPA, it causes more deaths every year than drunk driving.
