Wenger says that the best way to avoid pests is to be proactive by checking for spider webs, egg baskets, and cleaning the exterior of the house during the summer. Some of the ways homeowners can do this is either getting a power washer or spraying down the sides of the house with a garden hose. Having a duster on a long pole can help knock away any spider webs or other bug debris on the home as well. Checking the home's foundation for any cracks or openings is also a good way to check for possible problems, Wenger states. Any door openings, windows, or gaps in any part of the house should also be checked for possible

bug debris.

Mice are also a problem in the fall and winter months, and homeowners can also ensure they do not enter the home through a number of checks around their homes. Because mice can enter through smaller holes around the house, steel wool or wire mesh can be put up to prevent the mice from entering. The real problem with mice entering the home, Wenger says, is what residents do outside their homes that attract mice. "The stuff we don't even think about, like wood piles, landscape blocks, putting the trash out - all of these things can provide shelter for the mice," she says. "They even love climbing around your water pipes under the sink."

While homeowners can do their best to prevent mice and bugs from getting into the home, Wenger says, sometimes they will still find a way in, despite all the preventative measures. "Some neighborhoods are just more prone to bugs and mice getting into the house," she says. "But at Perseverance, we can show you the signs and spots where mice are coming in, as well as professionally power spray your house to give you a layer of protection all year round.
