In order to be able to react to changes in vision, a professional eye test should be performed regularly. However, what exactly is meant by the term "regular" varies.

Regularity varies with age. If there are no other symptoms, adults between the ages of 20 and 39 are recommended to have their eyesight checked at least three times during this total period. With increasing age, the probability of eye diseases such as Glaucoma or cataract increases. In addition, the adaptability in the near vision range decreases from an age of about 35 years. This phenomenon is known as presbyopia. For this reason, regular visual tests should be carried out at shorter intervals. After reaching the age of 40, it is therefore advisable to have an eye test carried out every two to three years. From the age of 65, an eye test is recommended every one to two years.

Drivers in particular should have their eyesight checked regularly so that they do not endanger themselves or other road users by reducing their reaction time.

The situation is different for children who already wear glasses. As their body is growing and this also applies to their eyes, their visual acuity can change very quickly. For children, an eye test should be carried out once a year.

Also important to note is that glasses must also be checked regularly for a good fit and adjusted if necessary. This is the only way to ensure a comfortable wearing experience.

Ophthalmologist or optician:

One can have an eye test performed by both an ophthalmologist and an optician. As well-trained specialists, both are qualified to carry out a professional eye test. The main reason for an optician's examination is the time factor. Often a test can be carried out directly on site without an appointment and long waiting times. Since the optician has the necessary technical equipment and routine, the visual acuity can be easily checked there. And if necessary, determine the values for the new correction lenses immediately.
