If it doesn't relight or remain lit, it is advisable to check for dirt or debris around it that might interfere with the pilot light. Other more serious issues like those involving the thermocouple or the flame sensor are reasons to call a qualified technician for service. Customers are also reminded to check the breaker before calling a technician. Sometimes it just needs to be switched on, saving time and money.
