Some of the therapies that can be recommended by the addiction specialists at WhiteSands are family therapy, dialectical behavior therapy, rational emotive behavior therapy, cognitive behavioral therapy, contingency management, and motivation therapy.

The addiction treatment programs may be as long as 30 days to 90 days, depending on the severity of the

addiction. Joe Ducey explains, "Drug treatment is designed to assist addicts in stopping their compulsive desire to use drugs. Since drug addiction is a chronic disorder that makes addicts prone to relapse, it is not uncommon for individuals to need multiple treatment sessions in order to make a full recovery. This could mean attending an additional 30-day program after their initial program is completed or attending an ongoing relapse prevention program."
