One important situation when a tree has to be cut down or removed is when a tree has died or has become weakened due to rot. Such a tree can fall any time without warning, possibly causing injury to people or damage to property. Trees with big bulging roots can also be dangerous and a nuisance because they can damage concrete such as walls or floors of the home or building. The spokesperson says, "In such situations, your best solution is to hire Tucker Tree Pros for tree removal services of these potentially harmful trees."

The spokesperson noted that there will always be people who prefer to do things themselves. However, for this particular case, professional help is required because tree cutting has been observed to be one of the most dangerous tasks, with thousands of accidents and also a number of death each year because people who are not qualified to cut trees attempt to remove trees from their properties.

The Tucker Tree Pros spokesperson says, "A qualified arborist knows each and every tree species in depth, being therefore able to recommend the best methods of dealing with them. Besides, safety is part of the training of these professionals, and their experience in cutting down trees can be extremely useful. If you have one or several trees on your property in Tucker which you would like to cater to or remove, consider hiring an arborist."

The spokesperson continues, "You might be asking yourself why spend money on experts when you may be able to do this work yourself. In fact, if you don't know how to cut a tree the right way, it might fall on you or some of your belongings, causing injuries and severe damage."

The spokesperson explains that there are a number of things to consider when thinking about tree cutting or removal. First, examine the health of the tree. And if 50 percent or more of the tree has been damaged or rotting, it is advisable to cut it down. However, it should be noted that those trees that have been damaged by herbicides may still be able to recover.

Second, it is essential to check on the health of the tree trunk. Substantial damage to the trunk will also affect the branches and other parts of the tree, that is why if at least a third of the circumference of the trunk is already damaged, it may be time to call in the professional arborists and have it removed.

Third, determine whether there are sprouts coming from the base of the tree. These sprouts indicate severe stress on the tree, so it would be advisable to consult a professional arborist to determine whether there is something wrong with the tree and there is indeed a problem with the tree. And then, the arborist can suggest a solution, such as cutting down the tree.

Fourth, find out if there are disease branches of the tree and if they are mostly found on one side. If that is so, then there is a possibility that there is something wrong with that tree. Once again, it may be time to consult a qualified arborist to determine whether that is true or not.

And finally, it is important to be knowledgeable about the history of the tree, such as when and how it was pruned. Improperly done pruning can result in problems later on. Also, soil level over the roots can change over time and negatively affect the tree. The spokesperson points out that if the amount of soil over the root

has increased in thickness to three inches or more, the tree may die.
