The video highlights people who have been accused of over-prescribing opioid painkillers, hiding lists of people in need of mental healthcare and overpaying benefits to veterans and the VA expecting for the overpaid benefits to be paid back.

While veterans have been getting help, other veterans have died waiting on help, but did not receive it because of the employee?s mistakes and dishonesty.

In 2017, Congress passed legislation that made it easier to ?remove, demote or suspend? employees for misconduct or poor performance. The Department of Veterans Affairs is on notice for those who have served the United States.
