And aside from memory loss, there is also impairment in good judgement, visual perception, communication, mental reasoning, and attention. Memory care homes offer amenities and services for helping seniors in their daily living. In addition, they have staff who are trained in providing Alzheimer's disease and dementia care.

For seniors who are in good health but require help with their daily living activities, residential care homes may be the most appropriate. These are actually residential homes or communal homes that have the capacity to house at most six people. Because they have a homey environment, seniors will feel more comfortable and relaxed. Nevertheless, trained staff are available 24 hours a day, and nurses trained in elderly care are available on an as-needed basis.

Other options are nursing homes, senior apartments, and independent living facilities. Nursing homes are designed for seniors who require 24-hour medical and personal care services. These are appropriate for seniors who cannot be cared for at home but need intensive medical care. Residents of nursing homes are often those who have a chronic disease or are recovering from injuries.

Meanwhile, senior apartments are for those who are aged 55 and above, in good health, and are able to live independently. They are healthy and are capable of doing their daily living tasks themselves. Likewise, these seniors can also stay in an independent living community.
