Their goal, according to Alexander, is to get a customer's environment restored to that condition where that person feels comfortable again.

What the professional hoarding cleanup specialists will do is listen to the instructions and conditions of their client before proceeding with the cleanup. Clients are always urged to participate in making the decisions on what things will stay and what will be removed from the cleanup site.

What the cleanup specialists would like their customers to realize is that hoarding results into a number of potential dangers. These include increased fire risk, reduction of escape routes and access for rescue crews in times of emergency, increase indoor air pollutants, increased risks for falling or tripping, possible collapse of structures, and the development of biohazards.

The hoarding cleanup specialists will go through the home and identify those things that the customers will want to keep and those that need to be discarded. Those that are considered to be still valuable will be categorized and organized, and are either kept or donated to someone who needs them.
