Daniel J. Hilferty is president and chief executive officer of Independence Blue Cross, one of the nation?s leading health insurers. Since Hilferty became CEO in 2010, the number of people the company serves has tripled to nearly 10 million in 24 states and the District of Columbia, including 2.5 million in southeastern Pennsylvania. Deeply committed to the greater Philadelphia region, Hilferty serves on the boards of the Greater Philadelphia Chamber of Commerce, the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing, and the Catholic Foundation of Greater Philadelphia. He served as co-chair of the Executive Leadership Cabinet supporting the World Meeting of Families and Papal Visit to Philadelphia, and serves as finance chairman for the 2016 Democratic National Convention. Nationally, Hilferty serves on the boards of the Blue Cross and Blue Shield Association and America?s Health Insurance Plans.

Partner in Recovery Award Honoree

Evolving from a partnership of prominent lawyers in Philadelphia a century ago, Duane Morris exemplifies a commitment to the community and strong values of philanthropy and good citizenship. In 2014, 85 volunteers dedicated over 3,350 hours of pro bono legal assistance to aiding human trafficking survivors, and another 50 volunteers dedicated over 1,000 pro bono hours to assist veterans and service members seeking disability benefits, compensation for combat injuries and other aid. Duane Morris has provided Caron with philanthropic support for more than 15 years and has encouraged staff to serve in volunteer capacities on Caron committees and the Philadelphia Regional Advisory Board.
