A low-amperage unit can cost as little as \$125, but that is excluding labor, permits, and other materials. However, depending on the amperage, the type of home, the number of circuits, the cost to upgrade can be as much as \$3000. Additional costs can be incurred, too, because panel upgrades tend not to be independent projects. Old units could have old wiring, outdated fixtures, damaged circuits or worn outlets. These will also drive up the cost of the project, especially because these components are needed to have a safe electrical system.

When asked about the costs to update or replace a electrical panel system, James said, "Yeah, that's true. It's going to cost you a fair amount. Let's start with the labor cost, which varies depending on the hours worked. The total cost to upgrade varies based on the amperage. What I can tell you is that it's not cheap. The process of replacing electric panels is costly. Here's the thing though, despite the costs, it is very important that these panels are upgraded when it's time.
