Newport Beach, California - Although many consider rhinoplasty a surgery simply to improve the way one's nose looks, that is not its only purpose. Rhinoplasties can also be performed to correct a deviated septum. This procedure is sometimes referred to as a septoplasty which could be covered by many insurance companies. The septum separates the nasal cavity and divides it into two separate nostrils. In many cases, the septum is a straight wall but a deviated septum turns, causing one nostril to be bigger than the other. Sometimes a deviated septum does not cause a deformity in the appearance of the nose but it can still affect breathing and lead to nosebleeds and sinus infections.

When a septoplasty is performed, most of the work on the structure of the nose is done inside and it does not always affect the appearance of the nose. However, it is possible to also correct the appearance of the nose at the same time with a single visit to the Newport Beach Rhinoplasty Center.

Many insurance companies will not cover typical rhinoplasties but if clients visit the right plastic surgeon it can

be billed properly in order to be covered. A health insurance company will usually cover surgery to correct a deviated septum if the client suffer from nosebleeds, have sinus infections that do not respond to other treatment, have difficulty breathing, if the septum correction is combined with repair of a cleft palate, or if the deviated septum interferes with other necessary surgical repair.
