One example involves a 50-year-old financial executive in Manhattan who suffered a sudden cardiac arrest and had stopped breathing. Nevertheless, he was able to survive his near-death experience.

The reason the financial executive was able to live to tell about his experience was that fellow residents at the bungalow colony where he and his family were spending the summer vacation were trained to do CPR. The moment he stopped breathing, his fellow vacationers knew what to do. One performed chest compressions while another called for an ambulance. A third one ran to the social hall to get an automated external defibrillator (AED).

As it turned out, the ambulance took 10 minutes to arrive, which meant that if the other vacationers had not conducted CPR and used an AED, the brain would have been permanently damaged and death would have followed a few minutes later. The patient regained consciousness a few moments after receiving the shock

from the AED, which caused the heart to work again, pumping oxygen-rich blood to the body and the brain.

Jenny Ashley, owner and founder of CPR Training Nurse, says, "CPR Training can make a difference between life and death. Administering CPR helps maintain vital blood flow to the heart and brain until emergency personnel can give advanced care. CPR, when provided immediately, can double the chance of survival. We urge people to check out the schedule of our courses."

They have been providing courses for certified instructors in basic life support (BL), CPR, AED, bloodborne pathogens and first aid for day care providers, church nurseries, elementary schools, high schools, nursery schools, middle schools, boy and girl scout leaders, and all medical professionals. These tools can make a difference between life and death. The BLS courses offered also provide certification and re-certification requirements to medical professionals.
