



Local Construction Company Now Offers Home Remodeling Service In Pinellas Park Fl

"As part of our ongoing public information help, we have recently issued some useful tips to homeowners on how to find a reliable home improvement service provider," says Lisa Johnston of PPHP.

According to PPHP, the first step is to create a list of nearby remodeling companies and take note of their expertise. "You can get recommendations from friends who have recently had renovations, search the internet for companies on specific areas such as <https://goo.gl/maps/NNPpDgALf6H2>, check out Google reviews, and join construction-related groups and forums online," she said. Only consider companies who

can provide basic information or some form of references, like an official website and ones with a strong social media presence/following. Excellent customer service is one important factor, and this will show up on how the company responds to comments and inquiries on their social media platforms.

Secondly, potential contractors need to be experts on the trade that the homeowner requires, they should also provide an extensive list of their previously completed projects. Normally renovation companies keep a list of the jobs that they have completed over the past three to five years. Moreover, homeowners can request for at least ten of their latest project references, together with before and after photos to assess the quality of their work.

“Once you have narrowed down the list of potential contractors, using the first and second criteria, it is about time to know more about their license and certifications. Ensure that the companies have proper and valid insurance policies for both your property and for their on-site workers,” says Johnston. Her advice is to immediately cross out the ones who are unable to provide the right credentials, or those who are taking a long time in submitting the required documents.

The next step in finding a reliable contractor is to directly call the references that they have provided. This is a very common industry practice that enables customers to verify the legitimacy of the projects. Ask important questions, whether the contractor finished the project on-time, if they consistently maintained the cleanliness on-site, or if they were given reasonable and transparent pricing details from the get go.

“Furthermore, if the contractor has an ongoing renovation project, or has just recently finished a project, you can schedule a site visit to personally see the quality of their work,” she said. Depending on the scope of the project, watch out to see if they are using cheap materials, or if they have subpar working practices such as poor seams and edges of countertops, paint runs/splatters on the floor, crooked tiles, poorly cut tiles, wall to floor separation, floorboard cracks, concrete wall cracks, the obvious results of a bad job.

“Finally, you may now ask for a project bid from the few contractors that are left on your list. Schedule an appointment with each of them and thoroughly explain the scope and details of your home renovation works. After the consultation, ask them to send a brief proposal that contains a rough estimate of the total cost, the types of materials that they plan to use, and a definite construction schedule and timeline,” she added. Clients should remember that it’s not always the best decision to go for the cheapest one. Sometimes, the quality of materials and excellence of the workmanship should matter more than the price.

In conclusion, it all comes down in finding an expert and ethical contractor with a reasonable price tag. “Research, plan, and take your time before signing on any contractual agreement in order for you to make the best decision with regards to your future dream home,” says Johnston.
