Spring Time Tree Service For Palm Trees and Evergreens

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Milpitas Tree Leaders, in Milpitas, CA, would like to announce that they recently expanded their tree services for property owners, residents, and businesses in Milpitas and the surrounding areas.

“Palm trees only need to be pruned to get rid of brown fronds, flower or fruit, so if you see those, spring is a good time take care of it,” said Louie Therege of Milpitas Tree Leader. “Spring is also the best time to prune evergreen trees and hedges, with the objective of taking away dead wood, shaping the vegetation, and helping new growth. It may even help give a future to an evergreen that looks past its best.”

As part of their approved public work, the City of Milpitas plants Street Trees in suitable vacant planting sites in the public right-of-way, and in tree planting easements. While Milpitas’s Public Works Department personnel are responsible for removing and pruning street trees and it is unlawful for a resident to prune or remove a street tree, they also stipulate that “the current resident, or if there is no current resident, then the owner is responsible for the adequate watering and protection of City street trees in tree planting easements.”

?Knowing whether trees on properties are classified as Heritage Trees, Protected Trees, Approved Street Trees or Unapproved Street Trees can be more than a headache for property owners,? said Therege. Property owners who don?t know the rules may find they are unable to remove a tree if it meets the criteria for a Protected or Heritage Tree. We recommend regular tree maintenance and monitoring to help ensure the landscape becomes as beautiful as expected.?

Trees are an important part of the environment and provide many benefits, from helping keep pollution levels down to muffling wind and noise. They make any outdoor space look better and help many people to relax. However, if left unmanaged, a tree could prove dangerous for people and objects in ways that many never consider, such as branches tangled in power lines and roots growing through pipes. They can even cause property and driveway subsidence.

As they grow and spread, branches often become unbalanced. Wild branches that haven?t been through pruning can scratch facades and windows, ruining a home or building?s aesthetic. Even small scratches can sometimes lead to bigger problems later. If trees are planted too close to home or buildings, the roots could damage foundation or underground pipes and cables, or they could fall and batter a house or building during a storm.
