For example, insulation or wiring insulation that are lying around or under the car can indicate that rodents could have been chewing on wires. There may also be rodent droppings in and the around the vehicle. Homeowners may also want to look for these signs in the house.

The problem with mice and other rodents is that they tend to chew on things like electrical wires.
