Tran explained that, "Trees are an important part of our ecological balance, helping to improve overall air quality by releasing oxygen and removing pollution. They also reduce noise levels in urban areas and, of course, contribute to the natural beauty and attraction of other wildlife. However, they require regular maintenance. When they become a hazard, they need to be assessed and removed by a professional."

Tree maintenance includes the removal of dead, damaged, and diseased branches as soon as possible, which in turn helps the healthy parts thrive. For non-blooming trees and shrubs, the best time to prune is in late winter, while they are fully dormant, and this is the same for summer-blooming trees and shrubs. For spring-blooming trees and shrubs, the best pruning period is immediately after they bloom, so that they have the longest time possible to recover. Trees which produce sap may "bleed" in early spring (like the maple) but the bleeding should not harm them. Generally, however, remedial steps should be taken as soon as issues are noticed, even if it is only to get a professional consultation. "Now is the best time to take care of any missed maintenance and tree issues, before they become a hazard," noted Tran.

Mismanaged trees or poorly trimmed trees can turn into real issues. Tree branches that have grown out of control can cause potential hazards, such as growing too heavy to be supported or tangling into power lines—an accident just waiting to happen. Poor planning and placement of trees means that some trees are situated too close to a house or pavement, creating potentially expensive problems and issues with foundations, pipes and sewerage lines, as well as becoming hazardous.

Any tree emergencies should be given immediate attention as they can create dangerous situations. Furthermore, this type of work should only be done by professionals with the correct equipment.
