They can squeeze into tight places, sometimes through openings just 1/4 of an inch wide. Otherwise, they are not above chewing through any material to get in.

When they get in, they are not through doing damage. If they are attempting to gain entrance to a certain area of the home, they will chew through other materials too, even if it is live wiring. One bite of a live wire could kill them, but the trouble does not necessarily end there. The sparks can ignite other flammable materials, meaning the house could be engulfed in flames.

If it happens that a fire does not start, homeowners could still be in danger. A live or dead rodent can spread diseases, putting the household at risk of becoming seriously ill. Some of the diseases rodents carry can actually become fatal.

Here is another thing about animal odors that Steve Johnson adds to the equation: "Typically when an animal in the attic is removed, the smell and odors that are left behind are extremely attractive to new animals wanting to move into the now vacant den site. When a home is properly sealed with wildlife proof materials, nuisance animals will move to another home that is easier to gain access to."
