Rabies is always a big concern with bats, which is also a bit of a paradox. According to one study, only 6% of the bat population actually has the disease. At the same time, that same small percentage of bats is responsible for at least 90% of human rabies cases, and that through bat bites. It must be emphasized that, in the unfortunate event of a bat bite, one must seek immediate medical attention. Left untreated, rabies can be fatal.

Histoplasmosis is another health problem that can occur if a person is exposed to bat guano, or bat droppings. Their feces emit spores that can cause respiratory dysfunction and can worsen to the point where a person feels that they have tuberculosis.

If the spore inhalation is isolated to the lungs, it can be treated effectively in a short time. However, this too must not be ignored or taken lightly. It can progress to a severity requiring hospitalization, and really severe cases can be fatal.

These concerns overshadow any damage that bats or bat droppings can do to the home. All the same, it can put a real wrench in a home maintenance routine. In fact, since fall is the time when bats will be seeking warm places to shelter themselves, it is a good idea to ensure that any potential openings on the exterior of the home are sealed up to stave off bat entrances, especially any that could be open doors to the attic.
