We also check the interior for problems with the gas valves, pilots, or thermocouples. These components help ensure gas is flowing to the fireplace in a safe manner. During an inspection, we also check for things like dust buildup, dirt and, yes, even bugs and spiders. These things can not only result in fireplace inefficiencies but also flammable hazards."

The company also inspects the damper and the flue, both of which are some of the most important elements of a gas log fireplace. The damper allows combustion gasses to escape through the chimney or ventilation systems built into the fireplace. Dampers must be opened at all times when gas fireplaces or wood-burning fireplaces are in use. The flue is the part of the fireplace that helps force harmful combustion gasses outside. When a flue isn't working properly, these harmful gasses could prove fatal. Kelly says, "The kind of thorough inspection that Northco Fire does will not only ensure that your fireplace lasts longer and performs better, but it could also save your life from the exhaust and harmful vapors. Plus, getting an inspection and the necessary repairs/maintenance done before they become an absolute necessity will also save you a lot of money."
