Sirent explained that in most cases, water within the soil creates resultant movements that disturb the foundation and causes it to shift from its original position. He said that these movements, or shifts, cause stress to the steel and concrete. This is how sinking, settling, and cracking of the foundation takes place.

He further advised homeowners to ensure that their water drains are far from the foundation of the house and that there is a good drainage system in their homes. "Landscaping can be utilized to help absorb residual water, and regular plumbing inspections can also help to detect water leaks before they cause any further damage to foundation of the house," he said.

In order to avoid the more costly repairs of serious foundation problems, it's always best to look for early warning signs pointing to the need for foundation repair. Sirent explained that homeowners should check their house for any visible cracks in the foundation itself, vertical or horizontal cracks on the interior walls, cracks in the basement or garage walls, visible sinking or upheaval of the foundation, uneven floors, and misaligned windows and doors. "Minor cracks are typically normal and should not be a cause of major concern, but visible cracks should be tended as soon as possible. Big cracks indicate signs of significant movement and may influence the building's structural soundness," he said.

Meanwhile, Sirent explained that home foundation repair is best carried out by a licensed contractor because they are the only ones who can properly assess the extent of the damage and recommend the most suitable mitigation method. "By hiring a professional contractor, you can rest assured that your house will be safe and structurally sound, and will pass any inspection test in the event that you need to sell it in the future," he said.
