The company displayed the frames as part of a lineup that included several new upgraded products boasting Bluetooth 5 capabilities, as well as Aluratek's Eco4life smart home family of devices.

The company's digital photo frames boast the foremost in "true digital" quality IPS LCD panels, with each frame utilizing an easy-to-use interface, a wide range of format support, and the simplicity of automatic playback. At CES 2019, the company showed off two types of frames: the 8", 10", and 17.3" WiFi Digital Photo Frames (with Touchscreen IPS LCD Display and 8GB Built-in Memory), and the 8" and 10" Wood Distressed Frames (with TFT true color LCD at 1024 x 768 resolution and a 4:3 aspect ratio).

As noted on Aluratek's website, the company hopes that these frames will help customers keep their "digital memories alive in full HD resolution, with incredible image clarity and rich and vibrant colors. Our functional and stylish frames make a great addition to any room of your house." Notably, these frames may also be put to good use as a form of digital signage. Aluratek asserts that companies may, "Enhance your message to your customers, showcase videos of your product or service in action, or play a greeting message, tutorial, educational video, use pictures in slideshow mode to tell a story, display business hours, sale items, specials, and menu boards, and so on.
