As radon is a gas at room temperature, it can easily enter the lungs when breathed in, where it continues to give off radiation; this practically means that victims of high levels of radon exposure generally suffer damage to their lungs and are therefore at greater risk of lung cancer. In fact, radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer in the US, killing more people than drunk drivers each year. It is the leading environmental cause of cancer deaths in the US as well.

According to the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Ohio is among the worst states known for issues stemming from radon exposure. Notably, it is formed by the radioactive decay of the element uranium, which is naturally found in all rocks and soils. On their blog, Radon Eliminator strives to inform homeowners about

The most direct action that a person can take upon finding unsafe levels of radon in their home is to contact a licensed specialist.
