Mold removal is essential because there are many toxic molds, such as the black mold. These produce toxic substances known as mycotoxins, which have the capability to interfere with cell processes and structures,

and therefore have the ability to cause serious health problems. Studies have shown mycotoxins to be present indoors, with victims suffering from pulmonary hemosiderosis or pulmonary hemorrhage, headaches, nose bleeds, immune system suppression, chronic fatigue, hair loss, diarrhea, psychological depression, dermatitis, sore throat, and various flu-like symptoms.

Black mold is also called Strachybotrys chartarum or Strachybotris atra. This type of mold has been observed to be closely linked to the death of babies from respiratory bleeding, and bronchitis and asthma. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), black mold has been responsible for more than 100 cases of lung diseases.

It is the spores from the mold that get airborne and that people may breathe in. These mold spores are microscopic and are invisible to the naked eye. Mold testing will measure and document the kinds of molds and their quantity in the air inside the home or property. The information gathered will be helpful for the experts from Bio Clean of Utah when they start with the mold removal.

It should be noted that mold is most prolific when the temperature is between 65 to 85 degrees Fahrenheit. The interior of houses and buildings offer an environment that is conducive for mold to grow and multiply. Aside from the temperature, also found inside the home are their food sources, which are paper, wood, paneling, drywall, and ceiling tiles. The organic jute backing of carpets in combination with warm and humid air provides an ideal environment for mold to reproduce.

Since black mold is toxic and deadly, this means that mold removal is not a do-it-yourself activity. If not properly done, attempts to eliminate mold can cause the spores to get into the air and breathed in by the residents of the home or building.
