So together we created Revival, using his medical knowledge and my discriminating taste buds, we spent nearly two years perfecting the first naturally-concentrated Revival Soy blend with about the same amount of soy isoflavones found in 6 cups of a typical soy milk. Within days of use I began feeling better." Suzanne Tabor continues, "Today, we expect to

reach many more women in our efforts to expand our brand. I believe this is because we offer a healthy alternative to losing weight that really works and also for providing menopause relief.?

Indeed, the soy protein powder for menopause has been found to be effective in reducing night sweats and hot flashes often experienced by menopausal women. Recent research on menopause in Brazil focused on the possible use of soy shake in decreasing menopausal discomforts in 60 Brazilian women, with ages ranging from 40 to 60 years old, who have become postmenopausal. This was a randomized, double-blind, placebo-controlled study with the soy shake given in two portions each day, providing a total of 24 grams of protein and 90 milligrams of isoflavones. The results of the study confirmed the possible benefits of dietary soy for relieving common mild discomforts associated with menopause, such as hot flashes and night sweats.

Meanwhile, in order to get the full benefits of soy isoflavones, up to six servings of soy milk need to be consumed each day, which may not be acceptable to many people. This is why Revival Products has developed a patented concentration process such that one Rival soy shake or bar contains the same amount of isoflavones found in six cups of regular soy milk.

However, a common problem with soy drinks was that they usually have a bland, chalky flavor. To solve this problem, Dr. Tabor and Suzanne Tabor developed a "Soy Without the Soy Taste," which resulted in the current available Revival soy shakes that taste delicious. This was confirmed by Annette Luther, MD from Winston-Salem, NC, who said, "Revival Soy products are nutritious, tasty alternatives to meat and have reduced some of the discomforts of menopause for my patients."

For losing weight, Revival soy shakes have been found to be effective because the soy protein helps a person feel full and satisfied; soy protein has a low glycemic index; and soy protein is a complete protein.
