According to Dr. Derrick Miller, the services that they offer at Advanced Injured Care Clinic include auto accident care, treatment for whiplash, treatment for work injuries, neck pain treatment, back pain treatment,

and treatment for slip and fall injury. He points out that chiropractic care is a kind of medical treatment that focuses on the conditions of the musculoskeletal and nervous systems. It has been steadily gaining in popularity because of it being a natural, holistic treatment that does not make use of pain medication or surgery while still getting results.

Many people depend on chiropractors for the treatment of various conditions, such as back pain, neck pain, shoulder pain, headaches, and migraines. In addition, chiropractors have been successful in treating other conditions like neuropathy, carpal tunnel syndrome, sciatica, and immune system disorders.

The types of treatment that a chiropractor may decide to use will depend on the diagnosis. Chiropractors will perform a series of diagnostic tests that usually include a physical examination and an x-ray. The chiropractor may also decide to conduct other tests, such as a CAT scan or an MRI. And depending on the results of the diagnostic tests, the chiropractor may use various kinds of treatment, including spinal decompression, TENS, chiropractic adjustment, heat application therapy, ice application therapy, strength training exercises, and stretching.

For auto accident injuries, the most common is whiplash injury in which the soft tissue in the neck is over-stretched or extended, which causes pain and discomfort. Through chiropractic care, the muscles are relaxed back into position so that they can heal from the injury.

Dr. Derrick Miller recommends that auto accident victims immediately look for chiropractic care after the accident. This is because most accident related injuries are not visible, and many victims do not feel pain until days or weeks after the crash. Also, many insurance companies will not approve a claim if the victim waits more than a few days to see a doctor after the accident. Common injuries sustained in auto accidents include whiplash, back pain, neck pain, concussion, lacerations, bruises, dizziness, broken bones or fractures, headaches, and trouble sleeping. Chiropractic care is often recommended for these injuries.

Meanwhile, chiropractic care is also recommended for treating work related injuries, including: slips, trips and falls; back pain; neck pain; and carpal tunnel syndrome. The types of treatments used for treating injuries include the Gonstead adjustment, diversified technique, Logan technique, flexion distraction, and soft tissue therapy. Advanced Injury Care Clinic is an approved provider on all of the major workers compensation insurance providers in Tennessee. Workers' compensation is an accident insurance that is paid for by the employer as mandated by the government. It is designed to offer medical care, rehabilitation and income benefit for employees who get injured at work.
