Lint collecting in dryer vents or in the lint trap reduces and restricts the airflow. This in turn causes exhaust gases to become trapped, creating the perfect environment to start an otherwise preventable fire. Over 15,000 clothes dryer fires are reported each year, many of which could have been avoided with proper maintenance.

Not surprisingly, the leading cause of clothes dryer fires is human failure to clean the dryer. Those seeking Utah dryer vent cleaning services naturally wish to understand the signs that indicate that their dryer venting needs to be cleaned. One such sign they can easily spot is their clothes and wash taking forever to dry.

Others report that their clothes feel very hot near or at the end of the drying cycle, or that the dryer itself feels unusually hot. Sometimes, dryer users report a burnt or stale smell. Often, they report that room housing the dryer unit feels particularly humid or damp.

Any time the hood flap of the vent will not fully open, this indicates a sure case of a blockage. Similarly, if it fails to close properly, it could also provide an open entrance for pests seeking shelter. In this situation, the airflow is restricted and the buildup is significant. ?Regardless of the cause, if there is any concern, we advise calling in a professional cleaning service,? continued Daryl Olsen. He added, ?Regular cleaning increases fire safety. It will also save energy and reduce utility bills?research has shown that this could be anywhere between \$18-25 per month.?
