It is one of the toughest parts of an HVAC system, lasting for long periods of time with minimal maintenance. Identifying these systems is rather easy as well, given that these systems consist of two components, and the name suggests. One component is located inside the house and sees more usage than its counterpart since it manages the temperature and redirects cool air towards the house?s interior. The other component is located outside the residence and redirects the hot air from within the house to the exterior environment.

After the standard split system, the most commonly used appliance is a furnace and air conditioner component. It is a popular system in areas where there is a constant need to keep the system on for an extended time. It uses a refrigerant as the heat exchange fluid, through copper lines, which means that a copper evaporator coil that is installed inside the furnace cabinet does most of the hard work. It is also more durable than the standard split system, since none of its components are exposed outdoors.
