This sets The Rhinoplasty Center apart as the best locale for rhinoplasty in Newport Beach. Specializing in rhinoplasty is something that less than 1% of plastic surgeons do. Being a specialist means not only dedicating your practice to excellence in a particular operation, but also being a pioneer, teacher and continuous student of nasal surgery.?

A key reason why Dr. Kosins believes they are able to provide the best rhinoplasty in Newport Beach for people of various ethnicity is that he was one of those who pioneered the technique called piezosurgery,

which he describes as ?rhinoplasty without breaking bones.? Dr. Kosins was involved in a study in which they were able to prove the benefit of adopting piezoelectric instrumentation in nasal surgery. What he means with ?rhinoplasty without breaking bones? is that previously, before the piezosurgery technique was developed, plastic surgeons had to utilize mechanical instruments like chisels, saws, rasps, and osteotomes.

New techniques like piezosurgery are only performed by Dr. Kosins at The Rhinoplasty Center in the United States. He is currently conducting research on patients who have difficult soft tissue envelopes. This is thick skin that has proven to be particularly difficult when getting nasal definition.

That they are able to provide the best is not surprising in view of the fact that they are committed towards the continuous pursuit of excellence, by making use of their varied experience and cutting edge technology to obtain the best aesthetic result. To ensure the best possible results for each patient, they take their time with each consultation and operation.

Dr. Kosins offer four types of rhinoplasty procedures. Primary rhinoplasty is for those who have never had an operation on their nose. Secondary rhinoplasty is also referred to as revision rhinoplasty. It is for patients who had several failed rhinoplasties. This type of operation is quite challenging because of the presence of operative scar, functional problems like difficulty in breathing, lack of cartilage material, and the element of surprise because it is usually not known what was done during the previous operations. Thus, secondary rhinoplasty will need a wider range of techniques.

And then there is the ethnic rhinoplasty, which is for non-Caucasian patients. They present unique challenges because of differences in texture, quality and oiliness of the skin, and the tip cartilages can be flat or very weak. And finally, there is the Persian and Middle Eastern rhinoplasty, which offers a special challenge because the Middle Eastern nose is different from the Caucasian nose, anatomically and aesthetically.

Dr. Kosins received his board certification from the American Board of Plastic Surgery. And he is at present a reviewer of the rhinoplasty section of the Aesthetic Surgery Journal and an active member of the Rhinoplasty Society, the American Society of Plastic Surgeons, and the American Society of Aesthetic Plastic Surgeons.
