The solar power is architecturally integrated within each ADU as roof tiles. These solar panel roof tiles are laid out in such a way that they provide a clean and contemporary look for the home. The ADU is constructed based on local residential codes using prefab, factory-built engineering. It is shipped 97 percent complete and then crane-lifted to its preferred location.
