Ductwork will also be inspected. Technicians from Advanpro Calgary report that compromised ductwork is

doors and windows. When too much air escapes, heating and cooling equipment must work overtime to

humid, or musty-smelling.

By investing in a whole home energy audit rather than taking a piecemeal approach to home comfort,
